

HARRIETTE JAVENS.



Harriett Javens, the daughter of Charles Javens and Maria Holland was christened 13th April, 1846 Willoughby with Sloothby Lincolnshire England.

She arrived in Australia with her parents and sister Ann on 27th August, 1850 aboard the "Lord Stanley".

On 25th November 1861 she married John Kable at the Church of Scotland Bathurst NSW. Witnesses William Cheney and Elizabeth Thompson.

Harriett was only sixteen years of age when she married and the marriage register records that "the father of the bride gave consent to the marriage."

John Kable was born 12th March 1830 in Bathurst NSW and baptised 5th May 1830 by Rev John Keane Bathurst Church of England Church. On the

certificate his father, George Esto Kable was listed as "Settler".

John was a farmer at Teapot Swamp (late called Moorilda) and was the next door neighbour of Harriett's father Charles.

Harriette and John had seven children

Children:

Henry Edgar: Born 10th January 1864 at Carcoar NSW.
Died 1937 Orange NSW
Married Mary Dunn 1913 at Orange NSW
No issue.

Albert John: Born 1866
Died 1932
Married Eliza Lillian McGeorge (born 1869 Registered Carcoar died 13th December 1902 registered Blayney) at Church of England Moorilda on 17th October 1887.

They had five sons and two daughters.

Albert died 16th December 1914 at Orange NSW, buried in Orange.

Annie Louise: Born 10th February 1869 at Moorilda NSW
Died 10th March 1947 Orange NSW
Married **Francis Robert Ford** (Born 26th June 1878) at Orange on 21st January 1903.

They had one daughter and three sons.

Charles George: Born 1873 died 23rd May 1957.

Married Susan Shadlow registered Sydney in 1898.

They had three sons and two daughters.

William Ernest: Born 1876. Died 1898. Was a school teacher. He did not marry

Matilda Lavina: Born 1885 died 1952. Married James J. Mitchell (died Orange NSW 1903) in Orange in 1902. No issue from this marriage.

Second marriage to Joseph William Hartas (born 1883 Orange) in 1905 Orange. Three sons and two daughters.

Arthur Hector: Born 1885. Died 1951. First married Ivy Maud Chater registered Orange in 1910. Two sons and two daughters from this marriage.

Second marriage Vera Gladys Brunker Registered Sydney in 1929 1 son

Harriette also raised the six children of her son Albert John Kable after the death of their mother Eliza when she was only 33 years of age in 1902.



John died on 4th December 1898 at Bathurst.

Harriett died 16th December 1914 and was buried in the same grave as her father Charles Javens in the Church of England section of Orange cemetery.

Her sons, Albert John and Henry Edgar also share the same grave.
